By Car from Larvik or from Oslo harbour:


Take the E18 towards Oslo, which automatically changes into the E6 in Oslo. Keep following the E6 until Kolomoen. There take the E3 to Rena.

Here you have 2 options:

- in Rena you turn right and follow the 215 which turns into the Fv607 at the river 'Søndre Osa'. Keep following until you reach Åkrestrømmen. Turn right on the 217. Continue for 6.5 km until you see a sign "Renåfjellet". Turn right and follow the road to the barrier. Open the barrier and go straight ahead. +/- 500 meters further you will see the cabine on the right side.
- the other option is to continue straight in Rena (11.6 km extra) until you reach the junction with the Fv30 towards Koppang. Keep following the Fv30, at Åkrestrømmen you turn right onto the 217. In winter this route is better maintained/faster.



If you come from Larvik: In heavy traffic in Oslo you can leave the E18 before Oslo and take the ring road 150. This reconnects to the E6 at the end. It is only 2 km extra.



A number of GPS systems direct you to the right where the cross is. This is a forest road. Keep following the road until you see the arrow.





2. Access to the cabin

Slide the top part of the lock up. The code keyboard appears and lights up blue. Enter the PIN code followed by the # After the beep you can push the handle down and open the door.

4. Ferries to Norway

Ferry crossing Hirtshals (DK) – Larvik (NO):

Color Line – 3u.45 min https://www.colorline.no/

Pets: Colorline is not pet friendly, dogs stay in the car (can be hot on the car deck) or the ship has room for a maximum of 7 dogs in the ship's dog cage in the kennel.

During the summer season (April to September), guests are allowed to have their dogs outside in a designated area on deck 9 on SuperSpeed 1 and deck 7 on SuperSpeed 2. Guests must sit with their dogs outside on deck during the entire crossing. Be aware that the weather has a huge impact on this option.

Ferry crossing Frederikshavn (DK) - Oslo (NO):

Also possible to extend or start from/to Kopenhagen

Pets: There are 8 pet-friendly cabins on the Crown and 10 pet-friendly cabins on the Pearl. The price for a pet-friendly cabin is +425 DKK per pet per way. A maximum of 2 pets per cabin are allowed (rodents are not allowed on board).

Pets must remain in the cabin during the crossing, but it is possible to walk your dog in the designated area of the ship. We recommend that you book the pet-friendly cabin well in advance.

Ferry crossing Kiel (DE) - Oslo (NO):

Color Line – 20u. https://www.colorline.no/

Pets: Colorline is not pet friendly, dogs stay in the car (can be hot on the car deck) or the ship has room for a maximum of 10 dogs, in cages on the car deck (own kennel). The dog can leave the car/crate in the kennel at set visiting times. (17:00, 20:30, 07:15) Only one person per animal during visiting hours. Visiting time is 15 minutes.

5. How to get in?

• At the main front door: move the upper part in upwards position:





- The panel will light blue
- Enter the code given to you by message and finish with #, you will hear some noice and you will be able to move the handle down to open the door. Don't forget the code, you will need it every time to enter the house.



6. Put the heating on

- As it can become very cold in winter, we never switch the heating completely off as it can freeze the water pipes !!!
- For the 2 living area's: at the right side, you can adjust the temperature by using the + and button. Do not change any other setting. When going home, please turn the value back to 9 degrees!



• For the floor heating (bathroom and entrance), use the blue and red arrow, also switch it back to **9 degrees when going home**!

As electricity is very expensive in Norway, we kindly ask you to use the fireplace instead of



the electric heating and lower the temperature when leaving the house.




7. Open the main water supply

- The main water valve is behind the washing machine in the bathroom. In horizontal position the valve is open, vertical is closed.
- Please always close the valve when going home and flush the toilet once more so it takes away all pressure

9. Cooking stove

• When you start cooking make sure the extractor hood is on. When this thing starts beeping (it goes quite fast when it detects smoke from cooking) just press 1 time on the button. (if you don't, the electricity will shut down!)



- When you can't switch on the stove you need to reactivate the safety module
- In the left cabinet there is a control box, press the button as shown by the arrow. A
 orange led will start blinking





- Press again on the button of the detector above the stove (1st picture)
- The orange led changes to a green one.
- Now you can operate the cooking stove



- Press the I button and put a pan on the stove. The correspondent area will light up (here the single 0).
- Press the single zero until it blinks, now you can use the small dots below from 1 to 9 to increase/decrease the power.

11. Waste

Inside the cabine you can find different bins and instructions how to sort things.

13. Check-Out list

We hope you had a fantastic stay! Before you leave, we kindly ask you to review this checklist to ensure everything is in order for the next guests.

Heating:

- Heating: Leave all heating units on. Refer to the manual for adjusting the temperature.
- **Before Departure:** Set all heating units to **9 degrees**. !!! This includes the two white radiators in the living and relaxation areas. Also, set the underfloor heating in the hallway and bathroom to 9 degrees.

Outside:

Chairs: Stack the chairs on the terrace into 2 piles and secure them with a strap. Place the table as close as possible to the chairs.

Materials: Return brooms and shovels to the spot where you found them upon arrival (in the right corner under the canopy near the entrance). Do not leave any materials that could be covered by snow or blown away.

Living Room:

- Refrigerator: Unplug the refrigerator and freezer. Leave the doors open at a 45-degree angle (both fridge and freezer). Place a towel underneath and put a chair in front of the doors to keep them from closing.
- Appliances: Ensure that all devices are turned off. Unplug all devices from the sockets (e.g., TV, microwave, etc.).

Bathroom:

- Main Water Valve: Turn off the main water valve of the house.
- **Toilet**: Flush the toilet one more time to release the pressure from the pipes.
- Ventilation: Turn off the ventilation system (set the switch to 0).

Doors & Windows:

- **Terrace Door:** Secure the terrace door.
- Interior Doors: Leave all interior doors open at a 45-degree angle to allow the heat to circulate evenly.
 - Windows: Ensure that all windows are closed.

Lighting:

Lights: Turn off all lights. The outdoor lighting operates automatically.


